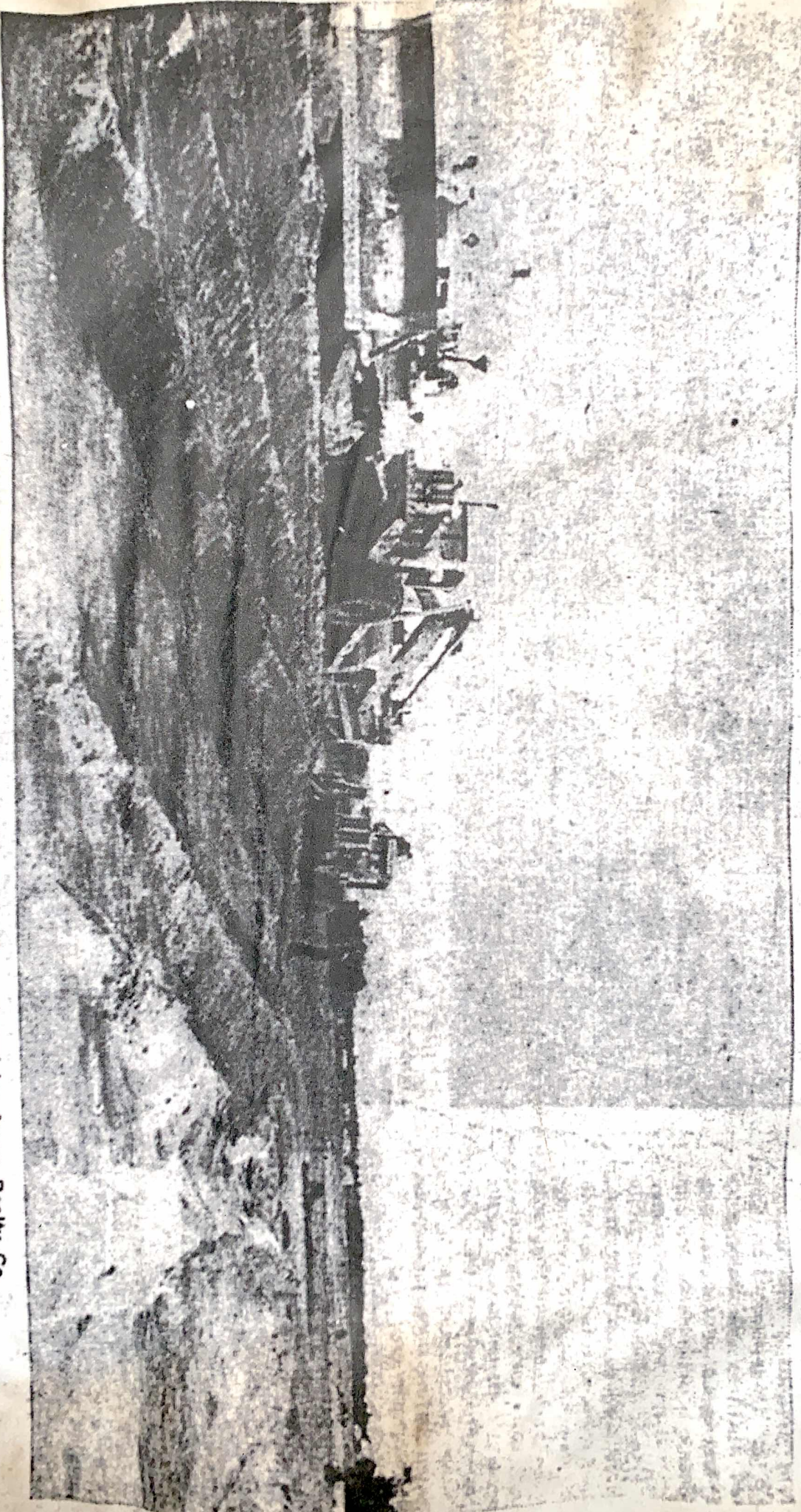


Project Underway Beyond Town Limits, Levelling Farmland for Airstrip



Work started last week on an airstrip in Ayersville on land purchased by Ayers Realty Co. from Mrs. Rupert Bradford, Geo. McQuat and D. G. Simon. Present plans call for levelling 4,000 feet of runway for a width of approximately 300 feet. Direction of the strip will be the same as predominant winds, which are east-west. Preliminary surveys had been made by Labrecque, Labrecque & Gagnon, consulting engineers, and actual levelling is being carried out by Marchessault & Fils Ltée, Montreal, who have brought along three "fournapulls", a D-8 tractor and a grader to do the job. The work should be completed in six weeks.

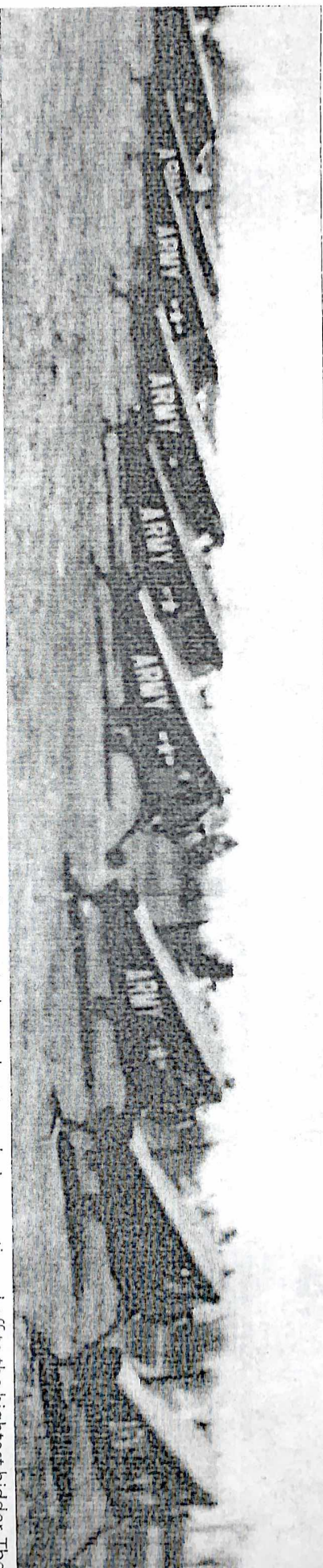

B.M. Aviation, in Lachute, was formed in 1973 when John Bogie and Colin McQuat invested in 64 Beaver airplanes that were being auctioned off to the highest bidder. The million-dollar purchase injected much-needed capital into Lachute and it made International news for being the largest ever airplane purchase of its kind.
